I think I have sold the concept of having some performance criteria governing the application of fireproofing to the GSA. This is in lieu of the very restrictive requirements which show up in the GSA guide spec. At this time they have accepted the procedures as shown in Sections 104 through 104.4. It may be that S.O.M. might be willing to incorporate this sort of thing in their specification which would still allow us to provide MK III as long as we don't exceed the T.L.V.'s. It would also require any other fiber material to demonstrate that they were also not causing a problem with rock wool or whatever their stuff consists of. Note in 104.1 we refer to mineral fiber and not to asbestos fiber.
